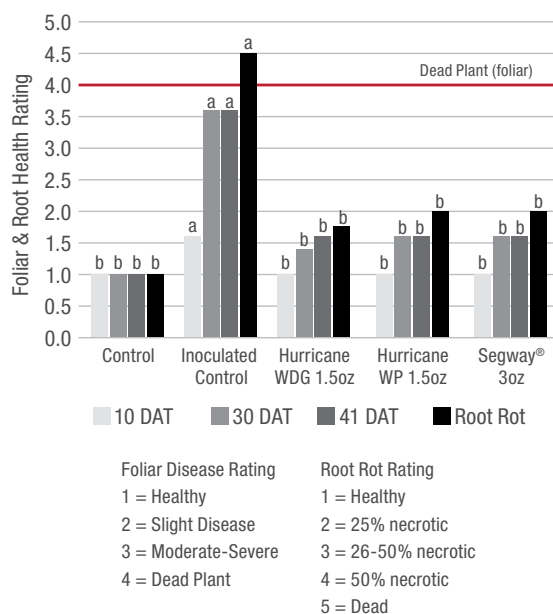

Flexible application methods

Hurricane can be applied to plant roots by drenching with microjet, drip irrigation or hydraulic systems. It can also be incorporated as a pre-potting drench.

AS A DRENCH FOR SEEDLINGS

Apply 0.75 oz/100 gallons of water – one application only.

AS A TREATMENT FOR CUTTINGS AND TRANSPLANTS

Apply 1.5 oz/100 gallons of water. It can be reapplied at a 21–28 day application interval.¹

AS A PRE-POTTING MEDIA TREATMENT

Use 1.5 oz in 0.5–1.0 gallon of water. Incorporate this into 1 cu yd of potting media. Uniform mixing can be achieved by placing the potting mix in a rotating drum.¹

¹For curative control of additional diseases such as *Fusarium*, *Thielaviopsis*, *Sclerotium* and *Cylindrocladium*, tank mix with Medallion® fungicide at 1.0 oz per 100 gallons.

Broad-spectrum performance

Hurricane WDG can be applied year-round on most ornamental greenhouse and nursery crops, including azalea, begonia, chrysanthemum, marigold, pansy, poinsettia, verbena, vinca and zinnia. However, use on *impatiens*, *New Guinea impatiens*, *pothos*, *geranium*, and *Easter lily* may cause stunting and/or chlorosis. It is recommended to test each cultivar under the growing conditions to evaluate Hurricane WDG use.
